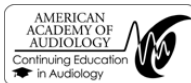
### Silent Auction Fundraiser Event

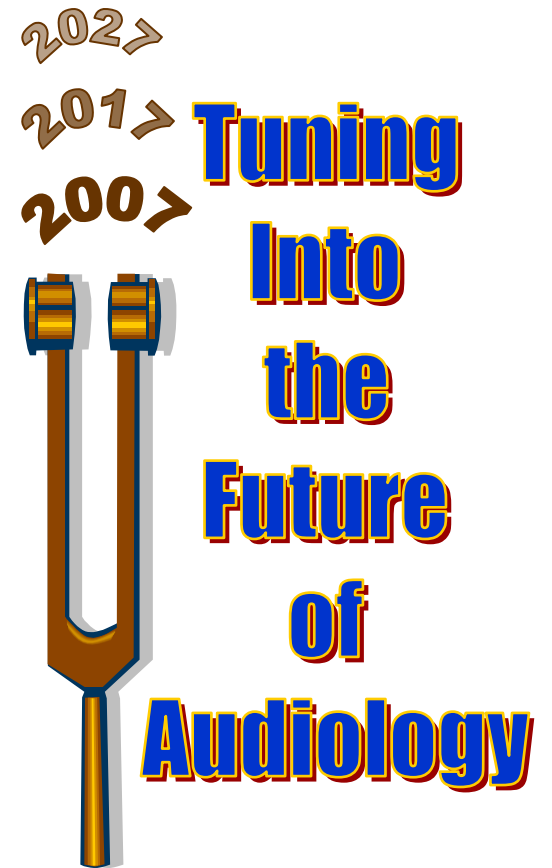
